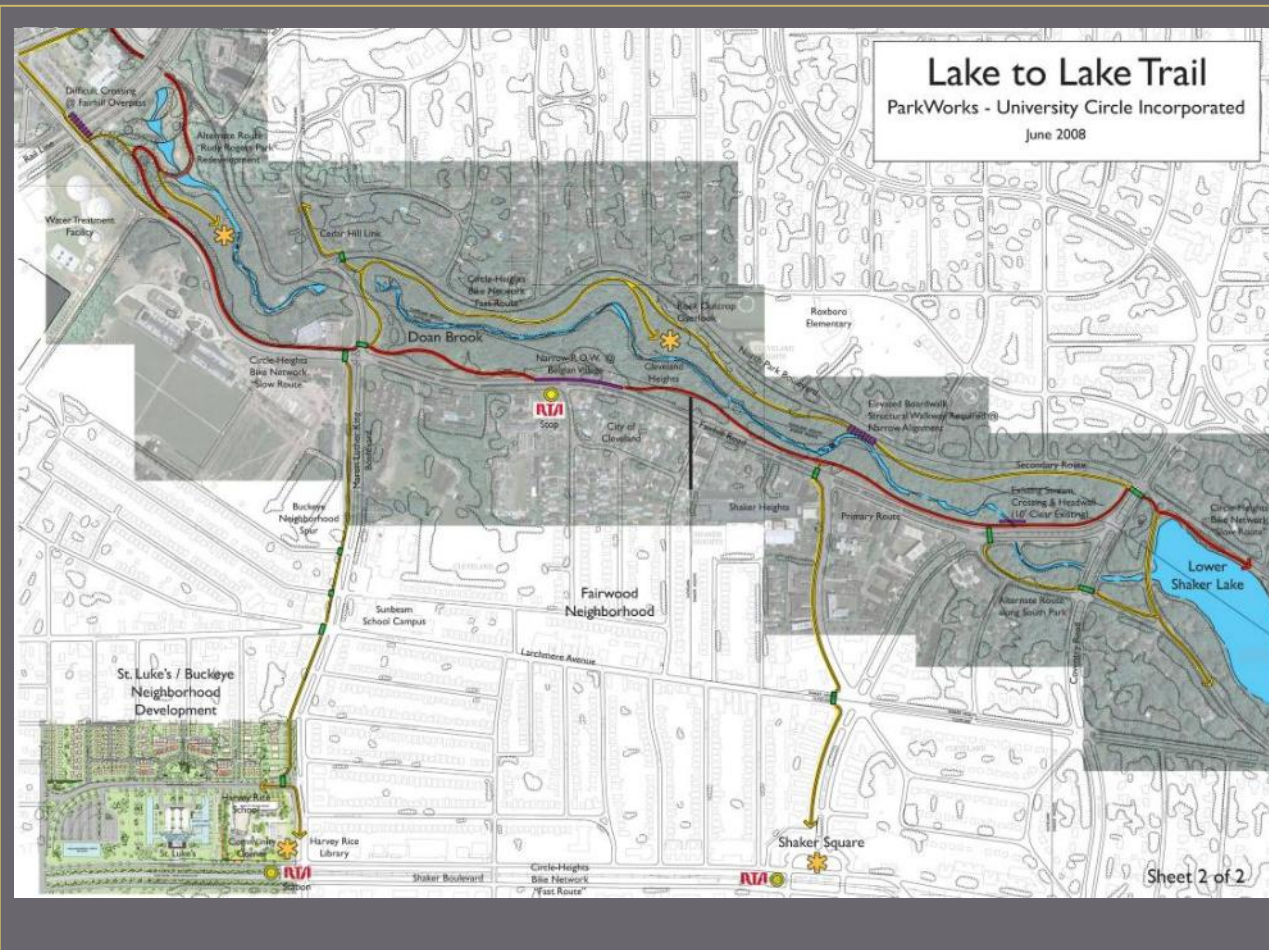


City of Cleveland – Lake to Lakes Trail
