The Good Stuff

- Connects 32 miles of the Emerald Necklace Trail, from the tip of Rocky River Reservation in Lakewood to the Cuyahoga Valley National Park via Brecksville Reservation
- Partnership with three municipalities from planning study through construction

Unique!

- **Benefits to the Public:**
Completes a major missing link in the regional trail network
- **Environmental enhancements:**
Relocated existing bridle trail to north side of parkway to lessen impacts
- **Social Equity:** Extends access to an area not well served by active transportation
