


Morgana Run Trail and Public Art Plan

The Good Stuff

- **Amenities** multiple public art installations along the trail. A safe way for children to get to school. Healthy and active lifestyle programming.
- **Connections to other non- project assets:** Other regional trails and parks (Metroparks and the Towpath Trail), Fast Track Cycling (dba Cleveland Velodrome), public art throughout the neighborhood, cultural institutions, shopping, and the Trailside Housing Development




Unique!

- **Benefits to the Public** estimates shows approximately 18,000 users on the trail annually. This is an 80% increase since the opening of Morgana Run.
- **Environmental enhancements** Planning is underway for the Morgana Bluff Nature Preserve and Learning Center, construction of green infrastructure storm water retention basin and greenspace by NEORSD along the trail
- **Social Equity** 50% of Slavic village residents do not own or have access to a vehicle. The trail provides critical (and safe) access to schools, churches, shopping and cultural institutions
